

**Bylaw No. 1498-24**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF THREE HILLS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO SPECIFY THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS SITTING ON THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 143(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, C. M-26, as amended, the Council of a city or town shall consist of seven (7) Councillors unless the Council passes a bylaw specifying a higher or lower odd number;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Three Hills, in the Province of Alberta, has the authority to increase or decrease the number of Councillors, as specified in the *Municipal Government Act*;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Three Hills, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Council for the Town of Three Hills shall increase to seven (7) with General Election in October 2025 and shall consist of the following:
  - 1.1. A Chief Elected Official, otherwise referred to as the “Mayor”, to be elected by separate ballot, and;
  - 1.2. Six (6) Councillors, to be elected at large.
2. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
3. Bylaw No. 1463-20 – Number of Councillors is hereby repealed.
