- Strengthen relationships between businesses and their local community.
- Improve the exterior and interior of businesses.
- Purchase of equipment to increase growth or modernization.
- Technology upgrades (point of sale, e-commerce solutions, website development, etc.)
- Office space improvements.



## How to apply?

The Town of Three Hills has committed to provide access to the grant assisted program for up to three x \$10,000 loans per year until 2023.

Businesses will review the eligibility requirements and submit a completed application and project plan to Community Futures Wild Rose (CFWR). CFWR and the Town of Three Hills will review all applications and provide final acceptance.
